**EXECUTIVE SESSIONS** – An Executive Session took place on April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, as well as April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, to receive legal advice from the Solicitor.

**ACTION ITEMS**

**1. February 26, 2025, Meeting Minutes**

Board member Sally Beck made the motion to approve the minutes from the Stormwater Authority meeting on February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Vice Chair Robert Kiehl seconds the motion.

**2. Board Member Resignation – James Milligan**

Vice Chair Robert Kiehl made the motion to accept the resignation of James Milligan as a member of the Borough of Ford City Stormwater Authority effective April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Chairman Tyson Klukan seconds the motion.

Board comments: Tyson Klukan thanked James Milligan for his time on the authority.

**3. Nature's Blend ERU Reduction**

Vice Chair Robert Kiehl made the motion to ratify the partial approval and denial of the ERU reduction for Nature's Blend following the successful completion of the appeals process, reducing the ERU amount from 46 ERUs to 2 ERUs. Board member Sally Beck seconds the motion.

Board comments: Chairman Tyson Klukan clarified that this was a partial approval and denial, elaborating on the measures that Nature's Blend has taken to manage the stormwater on the company's property. Nature's Blend had a total of 46 ERUs prior to their appeal, one of which was completely reduced to zero, the other reduced to two.

#### **4. DS Generator Sales & Services Quote – Pump Repairs**

Chairman Tyson Klukan made the motion to approve the quote provided by DS Generator Sales & Service in the amount of \$4,920.35 for generator repairs to the PPG Pump Station and Lower Yard Pump Station, and to authorize appropriate board officials to take any and all action to effectuate the same. Board member Sally Beck seconds the motion.




